SALZBURG FESTIVAL

Saturday-Sunday, August 23-24: (D)

Departure from your U.S. Get-Away City on your flight to SALZBURG.

Upon Arrival, you'll Independently arrange your Transfer to our 5-Star DELUXE HOTEL SHERATON SALZBURG, beauitifully situated in the "Old Town", next to the magnificent *Mirabell Gardens and Palace*, famous for their lush greenery and Baroque charm.

As we enjoy our full Buffet Breakfasts each morning at its *Mirabell Dining Room* or *Terrace*, we have lovely views of the *Mirabell Gardens* and can easily have a short stroll from the Sheraton Terrace through the lovely gardens.

Crossing the he Salzach River we'll explore the Cathedral where Mozart was baptized, the Collegiate Church; and the Residenz–Archbishop's Palace, with a possible visit to it's Royal Apartments. We'll finish with the vibrant Old Town Squares, the Festival Theaters hosting our performances, and the famous Getreidegasse, Salzburg's main shopping street known for it's intricate trade signs.

Evening—Tonight, we meet in the *Sheraton Lobby* and board our Coach for the drive to the Festival's GROSSES FESTSPIELHAUS to attend:

Giordano' **ANDREA CHENIER**, featuring Stikhina; Beczala, Salsi, Pinar/Armiliato.

(Grosses Festspielhaus- Concert format)

After "Chenier", we board our Coach for the drive back to the Sheraton.



SALZBURG CATHEDRAL

Tuesday, August 26: (B, OPTIONAL L) FREE DAY; OR OPTIONAL "BAVARIAN VERSAILLES" TOUR:

For those electing this Option-

After your Buffet Breakfast in the Sheraton, we meet Heidi and board our Coach for the drive through the Bavarian Alps to Prien.

On arrival, we'll board our Boat for the nice Cruise on beautiful Lake Chiemsee to the HERRENCHIEMSEE ISLAND.

We'll tour the Herrenchiemsee Castle and Gardens, built in the style of the French "Versailles" by "Mad" King Ludwig II, the friend and patron of Richard Wagner.

LUNCHEON with wine is at the Castle's popular Herrenchiemsee Schlosswirtschaft .

After Lunch, we board our Boat to return to Prien to board our Coach to return to the Sheraton.

We'll tour the Autogaphenkeller led by its Curator, seeing Mozart's original Music Manuscripts in the Mozarteum Archives.

We then enter the Wohnhaus, to view Mozart' exhibits and musical instruments from that time.

If available, we'll see an interesting Mozart Video of "Mozart in Salzburg".

Then on to the GEBURTSHAUS (Mozart's Birth-House) for a Special Private Concert on Mozart's Piano there by a Mozarteum Pianist.

After the concert, Heidi will lead us through the Mozart' family Rooms and exhibits.

We then have our LUNCHEON with Wine at the traditional ST. PETERSKELLAR.

Evening—Tonight, we meet in the *Sheraton* Lobby and board our Coach to drive to the Lobby and board our Coach to drive to the Festival's FELSENREITSCHULE to attend:

Weinberg's Symphony #2 -String Orchestra and Bruckner's 9th Symphony

(Grosses Festspielhaus).

Our Coach then returns us to the Sheraton.



SALZKAMMERGUT LAKE VILLAGE

Friday, August 29: SCHLOSS HELLBRUNN EXCURSION:

After our Buffet Breakfast at the Sheraton, we meet our Coach and drive to Schloss Hellbrunn, the Archbishop's Summer Home.

Evening—Tonight, we meet in the *Sheraton* Lobby and board our Coach to drive to the GROSSES FESTSPIELHAUS to attend:

Donizetti's MARIA STUARDA, featuring Lindsey, Oropesa; Davronov, Kulagin, Lehman/ Manacorda.

(Grosses Festspielhaus)

After "Stuarda", we'll board our Coach for our return to the Sheraton.

Sunday, August 31: (B, D)

FREE DAY-to explore Salzburg and perhaps to pre-pack for our journey to Vienna.

Evening—Tonight, we meet in the *Sheraton* Lobby and board our Coach for the drive to the Goldener Hirsch for our DINNER with wine.

We then enter the GROSSES FESTSPIELHAUS to attend the: THE FESTIVAL FINALE-THE

BERLIN PHILHARMONIC CONCERT/ **Petrenko**– Performing:

The massive Mahler' 9th Symphony.

(Grosses Festspielhaus)

Our Coach then returns us to the Sheraton.

Monday, September 1: (\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{D}) SALZKAMMERGUT EXCURSION:

Tuesday, September 2: (\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{D})

After Breakfast at the Sheraton, we board our coach for the drive to Vienna arriving at our 5-Star DELUXE HOTEL GRAND VIENNA, on the Ringstrasse, across from the Vienna State Opera.

Evening— On our first evening in Vienna— We meet in the Grand Lobby and proceed to its Top-Floor Terrace Gourmet Restaurant-1870s Le Ciel Rotunda Dining Room for our WELCOME DINNER with wine.

Wednesday, September 3 (B) FINE ARTS MUSEUM TOUR:

After our Buffet Breakfast in the Grand, we meet our Viennese Guide Kathi Trost, for a lovely stroll through the important sights on the Ringthe Burg Garden, Hofburg, and other sights.

We'll arrive at the KUNSTHISTORISCHE MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS, built in 1791 to house the Imperial Hapsburg Collections- the largest Bruegel Collection in the world, the Masterworks of Raphael, Vermeer, Velazquez, Rubens, Rembrandt, Dürer, Titian, & Tintoretto.

We'll visit the renovated Wunderkammer Collection of precious objects, and see many amazing creative art decorative pieces.

We'll then stroll back to the Grand.

Evening—This evening, we meet in the *Grand* Lobby and stroll across the Square to the VIENNA STAATSOPER, where we'll attend its New "Magic' Production of Mozart's

DIE ZAUBERFLÖTE, featuring Saenz, Fang; Pregardien, Nagl, Fischesser/Jordan.

(Vienna Staatsoper)

After "Zauberflöte", we stroll back to the Grand OR to the favorite Sausage Stand behind the Haydn's life and works. Opera House for a traditional Viennese Sausage with soda or beer.



KUNSTHISTORISCHE MUSEUM

Thursday, September 4: (B, L) SCHÖNBRUNN PALACE:

After Breakfast in the Grand, we meet Kathi and board our Private Coach for the drive to the beautiful SCHÖNBRUNN PALACE:

We'll tour its Imperial Royal Apartments, and interesting Carriage Museum, seeing its Coronation and Baroque Carriages.

We'll then have some time to stroll through its lovely Park and Gardens.

After Schönbrunn, we'll board our Coach to return to the Grand.

After a short break to clean up and refresh, we'll meet in the Grand Lobby, and stroll to the nearby Gasthaus Zur Oper Restaurant for our Traditional Viennese LUNCHEON of Wienerschnitzel (its speciality) and Beer.

Evening—This evening, we meet in the *Grand* Lobby; and stroll across the Square to the Vienna Staatsoper- to attend Verdi's

OTELLO, featuring Soghomonyan, Tezier; Osuna; Byström/Bertrand de Billy.

(Vienna Staatsoper)

After "Otello", we stroll back to the Grand.

Friday September 5: (B, Opt. L)

Free Day in Vienna; OR—OPTIONAL **BURGENLAND EXCURSION:**

For those choosing this Excursion: After Buffet Breakfast in the Grand-

We meet Kathi and board our Coach for the drive via Luxembourg Palace into "Austria-Hungary" to EISENSTADT-

First- We'll stroll through its lovely Park to Esterhazy Palace for a Tour of the Palace, including Haydn Hall, where Haydn's Orchestra entertained Prince Esterhazy.

We'll then walk to Haydn's Home, now the Haydn Museum, where he composed for the Prince- seeing several Exhibits depicting

Then- we drive to the midieval Town of Rust for our LUNCHEON with wine at the popular Seaside Restaurant Katamaran, at Lake Neusiedl.

After Lunch, we'll proceed to Rust's Old Town Center- for a short walk through this quaint charming Town from the middle ages, where numerous Storks nest on the roofs of the Village. We can also visit the Village Church to see its Medieval Frescoes.

We'll then board our coach for our return to to Vienna.
